Praying the Promises of God

“The Lord is trustworthy in all He promises and faithful in all He does.” Ps 145:13

DAY 1 Bearing fruit in old age

“The righteous will flourish like a palm tree...they will still bear fruit in old age.” Ps 92:12/14. Pray that our lives will be rooted in Christ so we flourish in old age. Praise God that even when we are old and weak, we can still be useful to our Lord if we keep ourselves available to Him.

DAY 2 His promise of deliverance

“I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him.” Ps 91:15. Are we going through trials and troubles at this time? Thank the Lord for His promise of deliverance, and that He will teach us through our difficult circumstances.

DAY 3 A cause for optimism

“Lo, I am with you always.” Matt 28:20. His promise of His presence says we can approach each day with optimism and hope knowing that we are His and He is with us always.

DAY 4 Hunger for God

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled." Matt 5:6
Let's pray this promise for the Spanish-speaking church that shares our facilities, that they will have a hunger for God and His righteousness.

DAY 5 His Shepherd's heart

"The Lord is my Shepherd; I shall not want." Ps 23:1.
Jesus is our shepherd. He loves us with His Shepherd's heart. We rest in the assurance of his daily provision, protection and leading.

DAY 6 He supplies all our needs

"My God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus." Phil 4:19. Pray this promise for the needs and finances of Grace Church as we look to Him for our provision.

DAY 7 God will never forsake us

"I will never leave you or forsake you." Heb 13:5. Pray this for the staff of Calacinto Ranch and Birth Choice as they faithfully carry out their ministries. When times are tough, God will never forsake them.

DAY 8 Your confidence will be rewarded

"So do not throw away your confidence, it will be richly rewarded." Heb 10:35. Praise God that all the perseverance we need for our current trials is available to us in Christ. And we have His promise that if we endure we will be richly rewarded.

DAY 9 Call on the Lord and be saved

"Everyone who calls on the Name of the Lord will be saved." Rom 10:13. This is a great promise for all people, including the Meyor tribe of India. Praise God that 15 of them called on the Lord and were saved.

DAY 10 Sing to the Lord a new song

"Sing to the Lord a new song...let them make music to Him...for the Lord takes great delight in His people, and crowns the humble with salvation." Ps 149:3-4.
Praise God for our worship team that leads us singing unto the Lord. How marvelous God delights in us.

DAY 11 I will not be shaken

"I have set the Lord always before me...I will not be shaken." Ps 16:8. Pray this wonderful promise for Olivier Melnick and his ministry to the Jewish people. Pray they will not be shaken by anti-Semitic attacks.

DAY 12 We can do everything through Christ

Pray for Pastor Bob and his spiritual leadership of Grace Church, and for anointing as he prepares and preaches the weekly sermons. Ask God's blessing on his marriage to Bonnie and their walk with You. May each of them daily proclaim *"I can do everything through Him who gives me strength."* Phil 4:13

DAY 13 He is coming soon

"Behold, I am coming soon." Rev 22:20. What a wonderful promise of God. Pray we live our lives as though Jesus was coming today, making the most of every opportunity to make Him known.

DAY 14 God will direct our steps

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart...and He will direct your steps." Prov 3:5-6. Pray this promise for our elders—Dean, Joop, Colin and Pastor Bob as they make decisions concerning Grace Church and its ministries.

DAY 15 Renewing our strength

The challenges of aging and health are something most of us will face or are facing. Pray that we will wait on the Lord, and that His promise to us will be a reality: *"They that hope in the Lord will renew their strength, they will mount up with wings as eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not faint."* Isa 40:31.

DAY 16 If we confess our sins

"If we confess our sins He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and will cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9. Let's face it, we sin and fall short of God's glory every day. But, let us keep in fellowship with our Lord by confessing to Him our sins whenever we commit them.

DAY 17 Let your light shine

"Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven." Matt 5:16. Pray all of us will be good witnesses of God's love to our neighbors, friends and family, knowing God will get the praise and the glory.

DAY 18 Be strong and courageous

Pray that the missionaries we support, including the Millers, the Pirolos and the Stotts, will count on this promise as we pray for them: *"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."* Joshua 1:9.

DAY 19 Don't worry about tomorrow

"Take no thought for tomorrow for tomorrow will take care of itself." Matt 6:34. Pray we surrender all fears for tomorrow to our Heavenly Father who cares for us today and will care for us tomorrow. Thank Him that He will either shield us from trials or grant us the grace to go through them.

DAY 20 Strength for the weary

"He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak." Isa 40:29. Praise God for His promise to provide us with the physical and emotional strength to perform whatever He calls us to do. Our weaknesses are covered by His strength.

DAY 21 God so loved the world

"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16. Pray this promise specifically for our unsaved relatives, friends and neighbors.

DAY 22 Do not be anxious about anything

"Do not be anxious about anything...and the peace of God that transcends all understanding will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Phil 4:6/7. As we encounter things that make us anxious, pray for one another that this promise will calm our hearts.
